


Wales - heart and circulatory disease statistics from the British Heart Foundation (BHF)

Health statistics give our staff, volunteers, supporters and healthcare professionals a sense of the scale of the challenges we face as we fight for every heartbeat. The statistics here are based on official surveys and data sources.

There are around 70,000 stroke survivors in Wales











Heart and circulatory diseases cause around **26 deaths** each day in Wales

premature deaths from hed and circulatory diseases each year in Wales



There are around 2,800 out-of-hospital cardiac arrests in Wales each year




Only 1 in 20 people survive an out-of-hospital cardiac arrest in Wales



Before the BHF, the majority of babies diagnosed with severe congenital heart disease died before their first birthday



Today in the UK, thanks to research, more than 4 out of 5 survive to adulthood



Around 30,000 people in Wales have a faulty gene that can cause an inherited heart-related condition

People with diabetes are twice as likely to have a stroke




People with a family history of coronary heart disease are significantly more likely to develop vascular dementia

People with heart failure are 2-3 times more likely to have a stroke















